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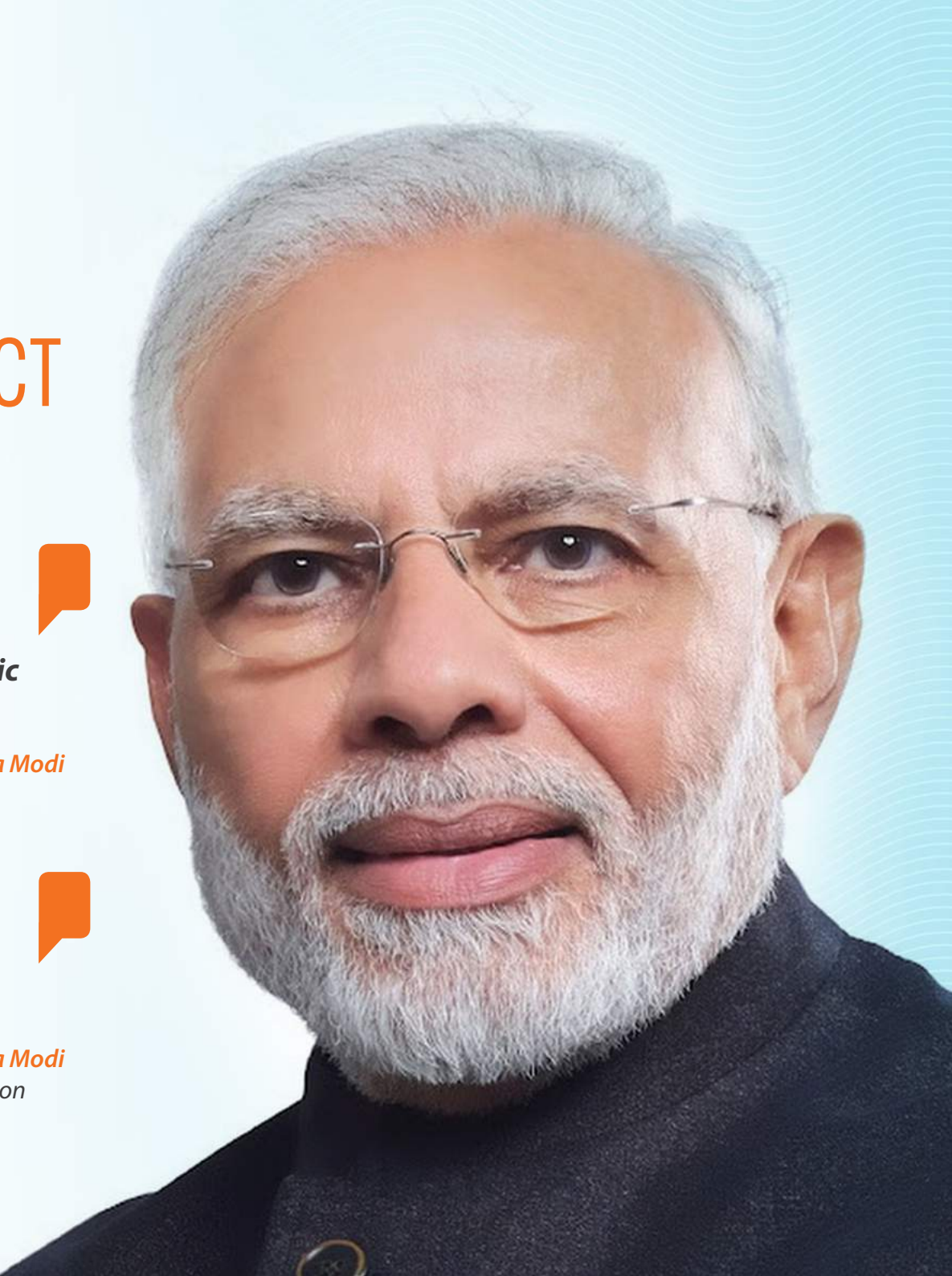

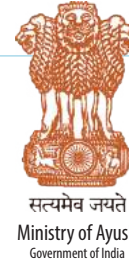

Health-conscious world seeks out Ayurveda

A world that is increasingly health conscious, and returning to its natural and ancient roots, completing the proverbial circle, spells good news for the world of Ayurveda.

A complete paradigm shift in our approach to the concept of wellness – moving away from what has till now been an area dominated by allopathy – that people are now placing their trust and lives into the hands of Ayurveda. With a growing awareness about Ayurveda, thanks to forums like the World Ayurveda Foundation, the suspicion and apprehension with which Ayurveda was treated in developing countries has made a turnaround, with people now seeking out knowledge and information on this well-rounded health system. A fear of things “synthetic” and “chemical” and with side effects is driving people to Ayurveda, seen as natural, without side effects, boosting immunity, and is improving the quality of life.

A global comeback

Ayurveda is making a big comeback, at the global level. European countries like Germany have always held Ayurveda in high regard, and offer courses in the subject. In fact in German-speaking countries, Ayurveda has grown from being seen as a relaxing wellness therapy to a complimentary system of medicine.

Ayurveda-based Traditional Medicine Systems (TMS) are very much in practise in most of the SAARC counties including Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal, and Japan. Australia and Switzerland have given Ayurveda recognition as a bonafide medical system, thereby allowing the setting up of Ayurveda clinics.

Needless to say, Ayurveda did save millions of human lives by keeping a check on the spread of COVID-19 and increasing the immunity.

The WHO International Clinical Trials Registry Platform shows that 1054 traditional medicine-related clinical trials have been conducted on COVID-19 to date, while the WHO COVID-19 database of global literature on coronavirus disease lists 3803 research articles on traditional medicine.

No less than 192 Trials on Ayurveda and Ayush systems were carried out to mitigate Covid-19. According to the WHO global report on traditional and complementary medicine 2019, the number of countries with a legal and regulatory framework for traditional and complementary medicine increased from 79 in the year 2012 to 109 in the year 2018 and is continuing to increase.



The World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) is a platform established by World Ayurveda Foundation to propagate Ayurveda globally in its true sense.

The first World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) was held in 2002 at Kochi as an outreach programme, to create greater awareness and opportunities in the practice, science, and trade of Ayurveda. The subsequent Congresses organised at Pune, Jaipur, Bangalore, Bhopal, Delhi, Kolkata & Ahmedabad were not only helped in promoting Ayurveda within the country but also had a huge impact in propagating Ayurveda globally.

Previous themes of the Congress were **“Ayurveda and World Health”, “Globalisation of Ayurveda”, “Mainstreaming Ayurveda”, “Ayurveda for All”, “Enriching Public Health Through Ayurveda”, “Health Challenges and Ayurveda”, “Strengthening the Ayurveda Ecosystem” and “Re-aligning the Focus on Health”.**

Prim Minister Shri. Narendra Modi, along with World Health Organization head Dr. Tedros Ghebreyesus, officially launched the first-of-its-kind WHO Global Centre for Traditional Medicine (GCTM) in Jamnagar on April 21, 2022. Through the GCTM, the alternative medicines and therapies are getting ready for a makeover under which WHO will promote the safe and effective use of traditional medicines by regulating, researching, and integrating the products, practitioners, and practices into health systems, where appropriate.

Data also shows that WHO traditional and complementary medicinal products were among the top five most downloaded products from the WHO website in the year 2020.

AYURVEDA FOR ONE HEALTH

One Health

One Health is a thought which acknowledges that the health of human beings is closely linked to the health of all living beings and our shared environment. This idea is not new. In fact, it harkens back to the ancient times when Acharya Charaka not only recognized the phenomena of "lōkasammita purua - the Universe- Man Continuum " but also its impact on health [एवमयं लोकसम्मितः पुरुषः।यावन्तो हि लोके मूर्तिमन्तो भावविशेषास्तावन्तः पुरुषे, यावन्तः पुरुषे तावन्तो लोके इति - (चरकसंहिताशारीरस्थानम् महतीगर्भावक्रान्तिशारीरम् 4/13)]. This concept has regained importance in the recent times due to several factors, some of the important ones being:

- Human beings' encroaching' on the habitat of other beings
- Extensive farming, Industrialisation, deforestation leading to climate change
- International travel and trade

These seemingly innocuous changes have led to the spread of existing (endemic) and new 'zoonotic' diseases- diseases that spread between animals and people. The 'Pandemic' COVID-19 is a severe case in point and a warning to heed the tenets of OneHealth.

One Health is gaining importance globally as an effective approach towards health issues at the human-animal-plant-environment interface.

The pandemic has highlighted that, fruitful public health interventions require the cooperation of all stakeholders in human health (doctors, nurses, public health practitioners, epidemiologists), animal health (veterinarians, agricultural workers), environment (ecologists, wildlife experts), and other areas of expertise such as law enforcement and policymakers. These professionals need to communicate, collaborate, and co-ordinate One Health activities. Other relevant stakeholders are communities and even pet owners. No single person, organization or for that matter country can effectively address the myriad issues at the plant-animal-human-environment interface in isolation. This 'Vacuum' is sought to be filled by WAF by bringing together all the stakeholders under one roof and forging a strong and meaningful network of professionals from all walks through this platform of 9th WAC. The discussions firmly leading to appropriate policy changes and action.

The WHO defines 'One Health' as an approach to designing and implementing programmes, policies, legislation and research in which multiple sectors communicate and work together to achieve better public health outcomes. The 'One Health' approach is critical to addressing health threats in the animal, human and environment interface.

9th edition of the World Ayurveda Congress has this very important overarching theme '**Ayurveda for One Health**' to provide a collaborative, multisectoral, and transdisciplinary forum working at the local, regional, national, and global levels to address the health issues spanning the entire spectrum of Humans-Animals- Plants and their Shared Environment.

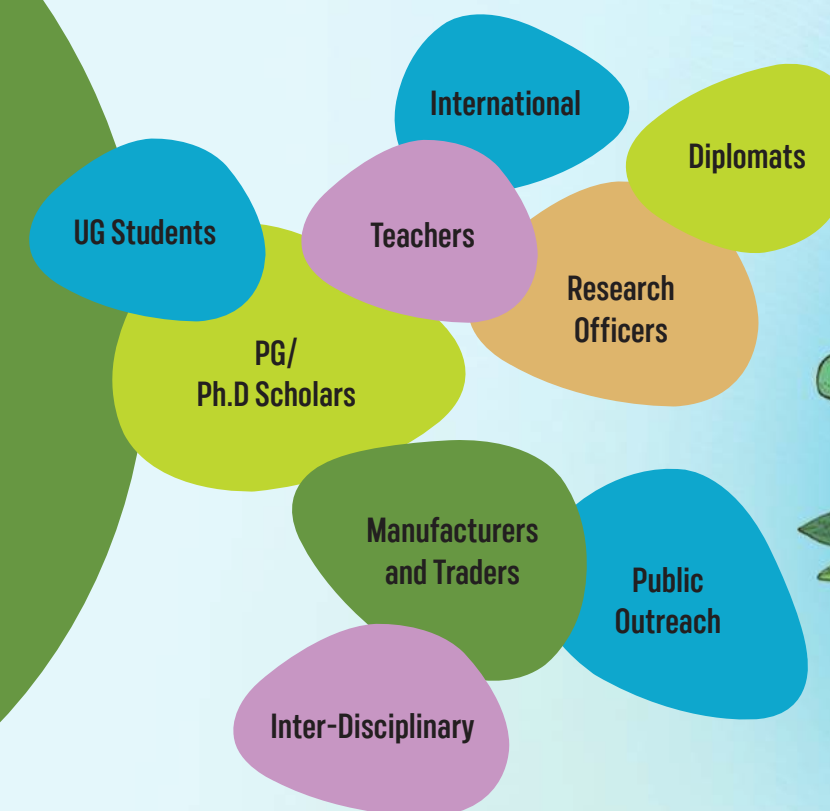

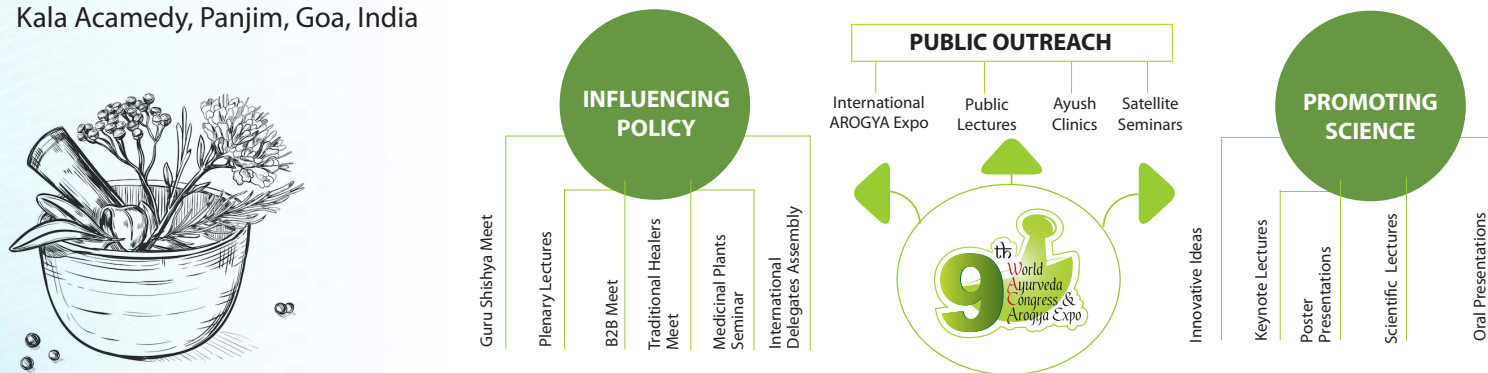

The **9th World Ayurveda Congress** will be conducting exclusive Scientific Sessions to showcase the recent advances in research made in the field of Ayurveda researches.

ORAL AND POSTER ABSTRACTS

The Scientific Committee of globally renowned experts will review the abstracts submitted as per guidelines given on www.ayurworld.org. The decisions of the Scientific Committee are final on all matters pertaining to the presentation and publication with regard to the Congress. The abstracts must be submitted online at www.ayurworld.org

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The title of the abstract should clearly indicate the subject of the research, the method and purpose of the study. If selected, it will also be the title of the presentation. The target group of practitioners, planners, manufacturers, consumer groups and traders. Scientific abstracts should not be considered as a means to advertise products. The World Ayurveda Congress provides alternate opportunities for the promotion of products.

To submit abstracts and papers, use the online module by visiting www.ayurworld.org. Abstracts submitted in any other mode will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of the authors that the papers are written strictly in British English. The editors will not do any text editing or reformatting. All diagrams, pictures, tables and equations used in posters should be visible and readable.

As conference proceedings will be available in digital form too, colours may be used in figures. Colour scheme should be

gray scale convertible for black and white printouts. All submitted abstracts will be peer-reviewed by the Scientific Committee. Authors will be notified of abstract acceptance by e-mail, no later than 15 September 2022. The last date for submission of abstracts is 15 August 2022.

FORMAT FOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS AND POSTERS

All oral presentations will get 6 minutes followed by 2 minutes of discussion via a moderator. Outstanding submissions may be chosen for longer presentations.

Submissions should be structured under the headings – Purpose, Methods, Results & Conclusion. This is applicable to all abstracts whether it is basic or clinical research including literary research works. Research is a process of asking a question and finding an answer by using a methodology to obtain findings.

This process should be highlighted in the abstract. During the Congress, space will be available for poster exhibition. Posters are graphic presentations of a scientific paper. The guidelines for oral abstracts are also applicable to the poster abstracts. During September 2022, a template for the poster will be made available at www.ayurworld.org. The poster should then be submitted as a PDF file to papers@ayurworld.org no later than 10 October 2022.

PUBLICATION OF ABSTRACTS

All selected abstracts of both oral presentations and posters of authors who have registered will be published in the Abstract book of the 9th World Ayurveda Congress. They will also additionally appear in the official journal of World Ayurveda Foundation, Journal of Ayurveda and Integrative Medicine (J-AIM).
